

KAYLA BEVERLY HILLS LONG DRIVE EXPEDITION

LONGEST DRIVE EVER ATTEMPTED IN MALAYSIA

Come and witness the longest drive at the beautiful Saujana Golf & Country Club.

Kelly Murray, the Guinness World Record holder will attempt to set a Malaysian record this Sunday afternoon. His target is 375 yards, achieved by Michael Gorton at the Bunga Raya Course, Hole No 1, on December 4th, 1994.

The Malaysian longest drive record attempt is part of the Kayla Long Drive demonstration, co-hosted by Saujana Golf & Country Club and supported by Malaysia's Premier golf publication, GOLF Times.

Professional Kelly Murray, who hails from Vancouver, has won three tournaments - the Alberta Open, Manitoba Open and Trinidad & Tobago Open. He has won 99 of 123 Long Drive competitions world wide.

On September 25, 1990 Kelly Murray set a Guinness World Record by hitting a golf ball 684.8 yards on an airport runway strip at Fairmont Hot Springs, British Columbia, bettering the previous mark set by Liam Higgins in 1984 by 50.7 yards!
